We're also trying to discern if there are things we need to do differently or if we're simply seeing the results of a culture that doesn't value church as much. Please pray that God would help us discern what steps to take in this area.





It's hard to believe it, but we're already planning Spring Break mission and spiritual formation trips. We have six trips this year: Guatemala, New York City, Amsterdam, Smoky Mountains, Miami Beach, and Muncie. So far, we have about 60 people signed up to go on trips, which is more than ever! Brandon is leading the Miami Beach evangelism trip and Jenna is helping to lead the Muncie trip, which focuses on helping our students learn what God is doing in our community and how they can be a part of it. Pray that God would send the right people on these trips and that he would use them!



Praise God! Our daughter, Penelope James Clemens, was born on October 6! We are especially grateful that Jenna was able to deliver her without surgery! Penelope is an amazing sleeper, which has been very helpful for us. Jackson loves his little sister and constantly wants to smother her with hugs and kisses.
